# Longshore and Harbor Workers' Compensation Act

STATUS



SITUS









= ELIGIBILITY

SEC. 3. (a) Except as otherwise provided in this section, compensation shall be payable under this Act in respect of disability or death of an employee, but only if the disability or death results from an injury occurring upon the navigable waters of the United States



Navigable Waters?





Navigable waters of the United States - Ian's Definition

A waterway on which you can directly or indirectly travel to another state, country, Gulf of Mexico or Ocean

Even if not currently navigable

US Navigable Waters = 12 nautical mile limit Waterway use not limited to commercial but includes recreational activities



Not Navigable Waters of the US

Land Locked Lake

Upstream of a Dam on a river, with no locks to bypass

WITHIN A SINGLE STATE

Coast Guard NOT determinative

Seaward

**Cove Tankers** 

Ship repairer on voyage from Philadelphia to New York -200 Miles out

Kolias v D.G. Marine Galveston, Texas to Long Beach, California

Not planned in foreign waters

Covered as sailing directly between two US ports.

Weber v SC Loveland 35 BRBS 75 (2001)

Extended benefits to employee injured in Jamaica Policy did not cover

"This endorsement applies only to work subject to the Longshore & Harbor Workers Compensation Act in a state shown in the schedule...."

#### Grennan v Crowley Marine

Coverage granted to Stevedore temporarily in Russia

#### Keller v Tracy (2012)


Coverage refused in foreign territorial waters and no regular Longshore exposure

NOTE THE DIFFERENCE IS REGULAR DUTIES

Including any adjoining pier, wharf, dry dock, terminal, building way, marine railway or other adjoining area customarily used by an employer in loading, unloading, repairing, dismantling, or building a vessel

4th & 5th Circuits - LA, TX, MS, WV, VA, NC, SC

Sidwell v. Container Services Inc & New Orleans Depot Services v Director OWCP (Zepeda)

Adjoin = "Lie next to"

"Be touching or bounding at some point"

#### **Functional Relationship**

Suitability of site for Maritime Uses

Proximity of the waterway

Adjoining premises used in Maritime Commerce

As close to water as feasible


